

EASTERN PROFILES

Dating back to colonial times, the Eastern region of the United States has a rich tradition of building with stone. The Mid-Atlantic states in particular, including New York, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland, and Pennsylvania, were blessed with plentiful and easily accessible stone — from the ashlar-shaped stone types of New York to the randomness of Pennsylvania rubble. The stone architecture of the region also benefited from the skilled stone workers who immigrated here, particularly from Scotland, Germany, Italy, and the Scandinavian countries.

Eastern region architectural styles were often built with an abundance of stone. From the early 17th & 18th century Georgian, Colonial and Federal styles symmetrically ordered and gracefully detailed, to simplified farmhouses, stone types selected for specific styles remain esteemed depictions for that particular architectural statement.

Eldorado's Eastern Profiles — Mountain Ledge, Country Rubble, Limestone, CoastalReef, among others — respects the shapes, textures and color palettes of the stone types found in the region.





NORTHWESTERN PROFILES
